
NON-RESIDENT TUITION SURCHARGES

All students pay the Instructional Fee, the General Fee and the Information Services Fee. In addition, those students who are not legal residents of Ohio must pay a Non-Resident Surcharge.

Undergraduate students who are legal residents of the University defined “regional service area” (which includes the counties of Chautauqua, New York; Armstrong, Clarion, Fayette, Forest, Greene, Indiana, Jefferson, Warren, Pennsylvania; and Brooke, Hancock, Marshall, and Ohio, West Virginia) pay a lesser surcharge than do students who are legal residents of other areas.

Effective with the Fall 2009 semester, undergraduate students who are legal residents of the Pennsylvania counties of Allegheny, Beaver, Butler, Crawford, Erie, Lawrence, Mercer and Venango are considered to be within the “Western PA regional area” and pay a further reduced nonresident surcharge. Effective Fall 2011, Washington, and Westmoreland Counties were moved from the “regional service area” to the “Western PA regional area.”

All undergraduate students who are legal residents of counties/states other than those specifically mentioned above are considered to be within the “non-resident, non-regional service area” and will be charged that surcharge.

Graduate students who are not legal residents of Ohio are also required to pay a non-resident surcharge. This rate, however, is the same for all graduate level students regardless of their county/state of residence.
