#### **Apply to Youngstown State University**

If you've decided that Youngstown State University is one of the schools you are interested in, then it is time to apply.

- Submit your Undergraduate Admission application with the following information:
  - \$30 **non-refundable** application fee
  - Official high school transcript
  - Official ACT or SAT results
  - Ohio Graduation Test results (For Ohio Residents ONLY)

#### **Financial Aid and Scholarships**

Once you've applied and been accepted to Youngstown State University, it's time to begin filling out information for financial aid. Priority Consideration for Financial Aid is February 15<sup>th</sup> of **every** year
